Right-of-Way Permits

1. When do I need to apply for a Right-of-Way Permit?

Any type of work done in the right-of-way requires a permit. The following examples apply:

Right-of-Way Use Permit Application

- Overhead (power pole placement, etc.)
- Underground
- Trenching
- Bore
- Pavement cut
- Utilities
- Landscape
- Driveway tie-ins
- Culvert installation

Infrastructure Permit Application

- New Subdivision Construction
- Paving
- Road Construction
- Development/Commercial Offsite Improvements and Construction

Grading & Drainage Permit Application

- Grading in Pinal County Right-of-Way - IF GRADED OR DISTURBED AREA EQUALS OR EXCEEDS 0.1 AC., YOU MUST APPLY FOR A DUST CONTROL PERMIT FROM AIR QUALITY CONTROL (520-866-6929).
- Clear & grub (wash, drainage channel, property where drainage may be affected)
- Subdivision grading

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2. How do I apply?

3. How long is the permit processing time?

- Once the permit application and supporting documentation has been reviewed and verified the average processing time takes 7 to 10 business days.

4. When is the permit available?

- Once the permit has been approved and payment has been received.
